PLANNED GIVING: Capital Campaign...

The Diocesan-wide *It's our Church, It's Our Future* Capital Campaign will soon be upon us. The Diocese has set a \$16 million goal, which will include \$1.3 million for the 2018 Bishop's Fund Appeal. Of the funds raised, 75% will remain at the Parish for local needs such as programs and capital improvements. The remaining 25 percent benefits the entire Diocese supporting Retired Priests, Seminarians, Camp Gugenheim and St. Mary's Cathedral.
