CHANGES TO THE MASS SCHEDULE AT ST. PATRICK'S AND ST. MARY'S ...

As was announced a few weeks ago, we will be making changes to our Mass Schedule. Starting on the weekend of April 28 (Divine Mercy Sunday), the Mass schedule will be as follows: St. Mary's will have an (Anticipated) 4:00PM Mass on Saturdays. There will not be a 4:00PM Mass at St. Patrick's or a 5:30PM Mass at St. Mary's. On Sundays, St. Patrick's will have two Masses, one at 8:00AM and the other at 10:00AM. There will not be an 8:00AM Mass at St. Mary's. While we know this may not be a popular decision for all parishioners, it is one that needs to be made. This will make it easier for visiting priests to help us on the weekends as well as for Noel and myself to avoid the travel back and forth to the two parishes, especially in the winter. We hope that our parishioners will be understanding of these changes and remain supportive of our parishes. We will continue to ensure that envelopes for each parish are returned each week for inclusion in our weekly collections.
