CEMETERY RULES

1. Artificial flowers, arrangements or gadgets are NOT PERMITTED and will be disposed of when found. This is due to safety reasons when mowing.
2. Small flags are permitted on the graves, but they must be maintained and removed when they become damaged.
3. The plot owner is responsible for the upkeep of flowers such as weeding and watering.
4. All cemetery work is done by cemetery employees or approved persons. Under no circumstances should you take it upon yourselves to have work done without contacting the office.
