We ask that you use the main aisle for Communion and form a single line while maintaining 6 feet social distancing. Once the center pews are empty, those in the side pews may cross over to the middle aisle for Communion. After receiving Communion, please exit the church.

**Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest (SCAP's) Part 1 of 3**

**If the pastor were not able to offer Holy Mass and no other priest were available to cover for the weekend, what would we do as a parish?**

For the record, we are not hoping for this day. Nor are we even expecting it. But we want to be ready just in case. While Catholics normally have an obligation to attend Mass each Sunday, we all know there are extenuating circumstances (illness, care for a family member, essential work, not to mention blanket dispensations by the local Bishop in times of pandemic are some obvious examples). Hopefully barring these circumstances, Mass will be available. In some cases, we must drive farther than we are used to or go at a different time. But in very extraordinary times when none of these options are a possibility, a SCAP can be offered. Here at [Parish Name] (and in most parishes across the Diocese) we have parishioners who have been trained to lead others in prayer. In the next couple weeks, we will share with you who would be offering these SCAPs and what they would look like. But for now, it is important for you to know: If you can make it to Mass, there is no substitute for that. If you cannot, it is still good to come together as the people of God and pray. And that is where a SCAP can come in.

**COVID Clarification**

Do people need to continue wearing masks throughout the entire time they are in the church —especially when it is hot?

Wearing masks is essential. All those who are not taking a speaking part during the liturgy are required to please keep their masks on as they are able. If they are unable, they must refrain from moving about, singing, or projecting their voices in other ways. This is in line with the intention of the NYS guideline.
