REVISED GUIDELINES FOR PARISH LIFE

The obligation to attend Sunday Mass in the Diocese of Ogdensburg has been reinstated. Parishioners who are fully vaccinated are not required to wear a face mask at Mass. Children under 12 who are not vaccine-eligible and those under the age of 16 who have not been vaccinated, may accompany and be seated with the vaccinated adult. **Those who are not fully vaccinated should observe 6-foot social distancing from individuals not in their household and wear a face mask except when receiving Holy Communion.** Hand sanitizers will still be available at the church entrances. At Communion, parishioners are responsible for maintaining social distancing from those not in their household. Please note that Communion should be received in the hand only as this is the best way to ensure everyone's safety at this time. Thank you for your continued support, understanding and cooperation!
