THE CREED: Virtual Series via Zoom.

Every Sunday and Holyday, we recite at Mass our Profession of Faith. In the past we have used the Nicene Creed. We now use the Apostles Creed. Both Creeds contain the basics of our faith as defined in the very early centuries of the Church. However, how familiar are we with those words that we use? Could we really explain "Light from Light", "Consubstantial with the Father", the "Communion of Saints"? Bishop Barron has written a new book to explain the contents of the Creed, specifically the Nicene Creed. In addition to the book, there is a marvelous video series to present the content. Beginning on Monday, September 13 at 6:30 pm online, Msrg. Aucoin will offer a series to watch the video and review the contents of our faith. In all, there will be five sessions.
