

Class Expectations For in School Learners

- 7:45 - 8:15 is breakfast
- Morning Assembly is at 8:15 with Mrs. Gonzalez through Zoom link
- Class live stream is active at 8:30
- Students are to be in school uniform, except on gym days when they are to wear gym uniform
- Students should be prepared with notebooks, pens, pencils, and books for class, and art supplies for Mr. T
- Students are to wear Masks and sanitize hands when coming into class
- Students are to complete assignments in a timely manner.
- Participation will be important as part of grade, since handouts will not be collected
- Students need to know their login information for gmail. Any other sites that are used they will need to keep track of
- Students in school will need to be respectful when teacher is working with at home student
- Students will be expected to abide by handbook and follow proper classroom etiquette
- Students should check the class pages of all of their teachers

Expectations for Remote Learners

- Students need to be logged for the morning Zoom for Ms. Gonzalez's morning assembly
- Students need to join the class live stream after the morning assembly has ended

- Students are to wear school uniform. On gym days they are to wear gym uniform
- Students should create a work space at home that is free from distractions and background noise. This work space should have all books and supplies needed for the day.
- Students should set camera up so their face is occupying most of the screen
- Students should follow teacher's directions on using camera and mic. No one should call out on zoom, unless there is an emergency - connection is shaky
- Students should not eat during class, having water is fine.
- Students should ask to use the restroom, not just disappear.
- Participation from home will be very important. Students must make an effort to contribute their answers/ideas in class.
- Students should complete assignments in a timely manner
- If the zoom has an issue and the live stream is impossible to follow, students should use the enrichment center on webpages to do work
- In the case zoom goes out, parents should email the teacher to inform them

Grading Policy

- homework

Homework/Classwork Assignments

- For some assignments students may be graded on a check, check plus, or check minus. These are to give students an idea of if they are giving acceptable answers.
- Handing in classwork and homework assignments on time is of the utmost importance
- For some assignments, students may receive a letter grade, this is not a quiz or test. The assignment may just be given more weight as a classwork or homework assignment.

Test/Quizzes

- These will be graded as either letter grades or on a percent of 100.

Students should be aware that reading at home is part of their responsibility. If they do not read when such an assignment is given, then we can not spend the class discussing the topic. Students who demonstrate that they are not reading (by lack of participation or quality of answers) will have their homework/classwork grades affected
