Assessments this week

Math – Test Tuesday on Lessons 1-8 (Use Powers of 10 to Estimate Quantities) and 1-9 (Understand Scientific Notation) – moved from Friday of last week

ELA – Thursday – Writing assignment on Richard Blanco’s poems “America” and “One Today” will be done in class and used as a quiz grade

Reminders:

- All written homework assignments, as well as studying assignments, need to be written in the planner each day.
- All assignments need to be submitted the day that they are due. If you do not finish an assignment during class, you are reminded by me that you need to finish it for homework and submit it the following day.
