Attendance and Punctuality: it is important to be on time every day. Announcements begin at 8:00. Students need to be in class by 8:20 which is when we begin our day.

Classes taught: Religion, ELA (Reading, Handwriting, Composition, and Spelling) Social Studies, Science, and Math. The schedule is posted on the class pages.

Books Covered: All books must be covered. Hard cover books (Science and SS must be covered with stretchy book sox). Soft covered books must be covered with clear contact paper.

Supplies: Please make sure your child has all the supplies required on the supply list (headphones, notebooks, and folders are the most important)

Lunch/Recess: 11:20-12:20. Lunch is in the cafeteria and then students will go outside for recess (weather permitting)

Bathroom Schedule: once in the morning and once in the afternoon. In an emergency students will be allowed to go more than once.

Students have a home family email (gmail account). We will use Google classroom. Tests will be given by email/google classroom.

Grading:

Students will be graded on quizzes, tests, classwork, homework, and projects. (They will be on the weekly letter on the class pages) You will see most of their grades on google classroom. The first project is on Hispanic Heritage (which was already posted). It is due on October 5.

Extra Credit: Students who received a 70 or below on a test may do extra credit. All they have to do is write the questions and correct answers for the ones they got wrong and submit it to me.

Assignments

Some assignments need to be completed and emailed to me. I will let you know when this is the case. It can be submitted via Google classroom or you can take a picture and email it to me.

The two most important items for you to look for are: the **homework planner** and **test/events schedule**. The test/events schedule is posted on Google classroom and on the class pages. On Fridays, you can see all of the classwork for the week on Google classroom.

Every night there should be something written in your child's planner. If your child does not do an assignment, I will send an email or write a note in their planner. Please reply so I know you are aware of the missed assignment. Your child will get an extra day, but if the work is not completed by the second day, he/she will receive a zero.

School Uniform: Proper uniform is required. Proper shoes need to be worn daily except on Gym days. On gym days shorts and t-shirt and sneakers or sweat suits and sneakers may be worn to school.
