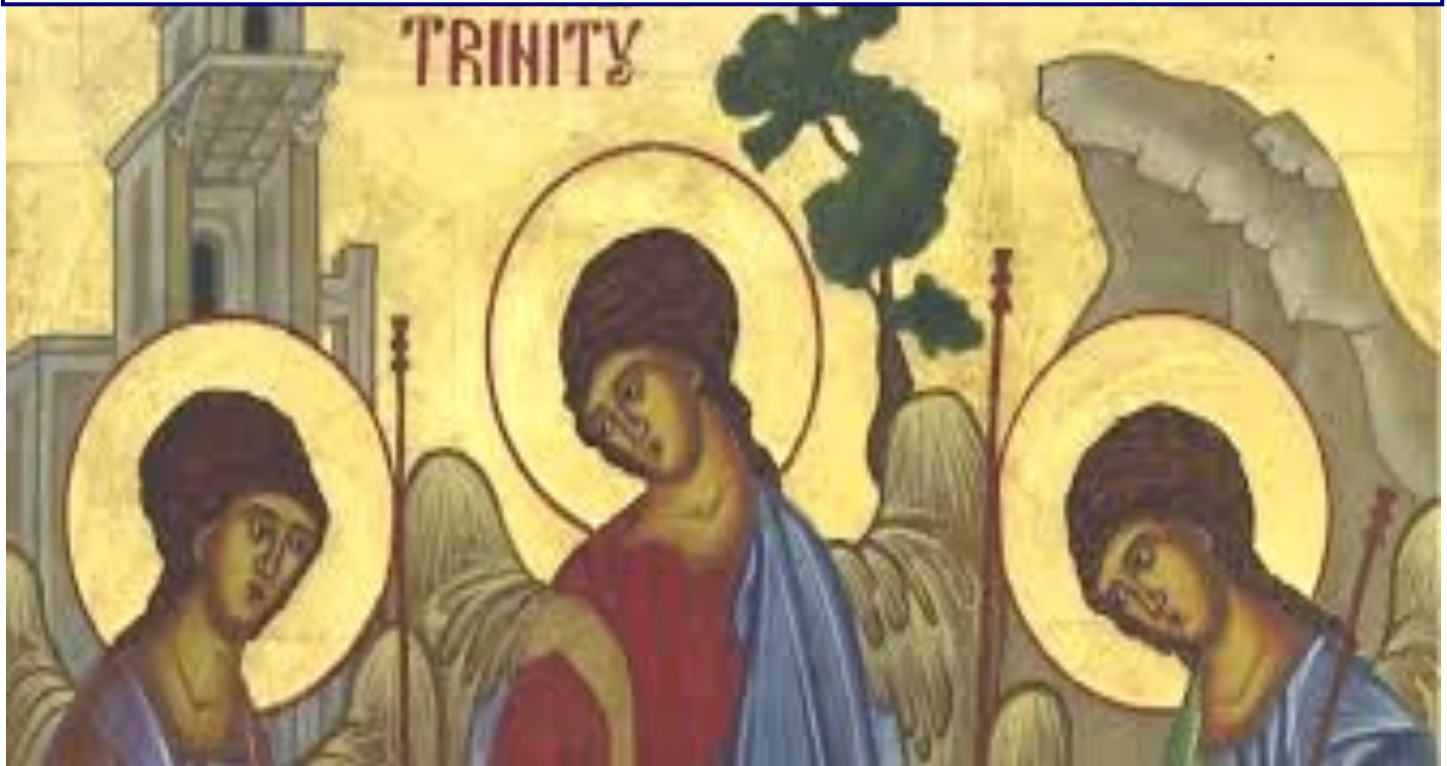

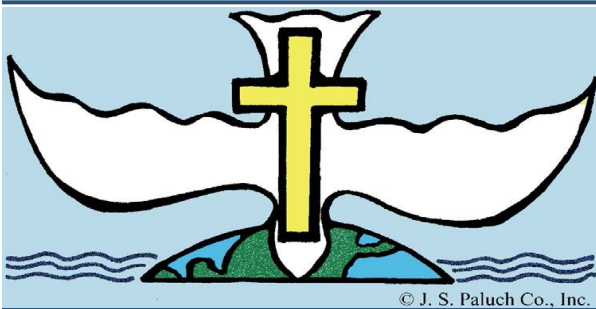

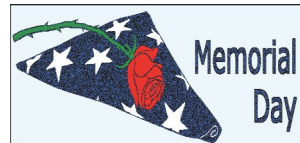

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

In Vigil of First Friday, there will be Holy Hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament on **Thursday, May 31st** from **4:00-5:00 PM** with our daily Mass being celebrated at 5:00 PM. All are encouraged to come and spend some quiet time with our Lord.

Our next **scripture study** begins **May 30, 2018**. The study is titled **Daring to Walk the Walk**. This is the second part of a series called **Walking Toward Eternity**. It is a challenging study that can open our eyes to obstacles in our Christian walk such as greed, envy, fear, and shame. Through prayer, reflection, guidance, and the aid of the Holy Spirit, we begin to engage these difficulties in a positive way as we continue toward our goal of union with Christ. Centennial News

St. Martin de Tours Dedicated—On June 2, 1844, the current structure of St. Martin de Tours church was dedicated by Archbishop Blanc. Fundraising to build a new church began as early as 1820 and construction began in 1836. The parish of St. Martin de Tours is the Mother Church of the Acadians, as it was the first parish established in Southwest Louisiana after the arrival of the Acadians in 1765. While the historic church has undergone many renovations through the years, it continues to stand as a testimony to the faith of the Acadian settlers and of their descendants today.

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OUR FAITH

Today is a day simply to ponder the fact that in baptism we were claimed by God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The first reading from Deuteronomy prompts us to fix in our hearts the truth that God is the Lord of both heaven and earth and there is no other god. Saint Paul reminds us that, because we received the Spirit of adoption in baptism, we are now children of God. In the Gospel Jesus charges us with the responsibility to make other disciples. These realities make today's solemnity a day of praise, adoration, and responsibility. It is a fitting day to thank God for the absolutely free gift of faith that we were given in baptism. It is also a day to ask God for strength to take on the responsibility of sharing that faith with others.
