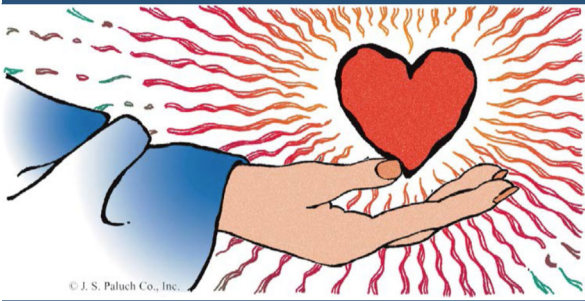

UPDATE ON SPECIAL COLLECTION

May 25/26 Mission Appeal for the Catholic Diocese of Ijebu-Ode: Next weekend we will welcome Fr. Stephen from the Western part of Nigeria, a Diocese whose population is 50% Muslim, 25% Christians of other denominations, 15% Catholic and 10% Traditional African believers. They do not have enough material and financial resources to sustain the developing programs of evangelization, sustenance of priest and religious, training of seminarians and to sustain primary health care projects for the villagers. Please be generous.
