On **Saturday, July 4th**, we will celebrate a **daily Mass at 8:00 AM**. All are invited to attend.

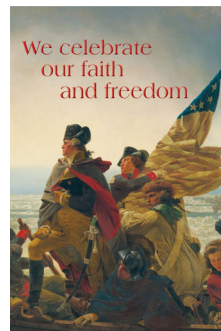
**WE ARE BACK IN CHURCH!**
