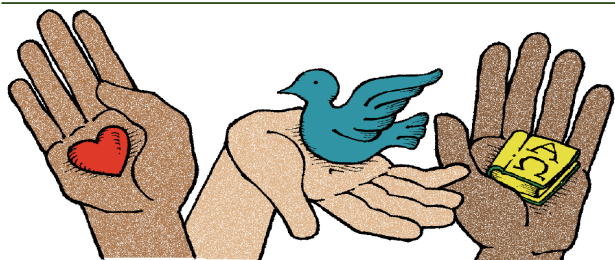

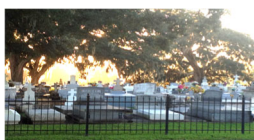

Love Life Amendment: On the November 3rd ballot, you will have the opportunity to vote for a pro-life constitutional amendment called the **“Love Life Amendment.”** The ballot will state: “Do you support an amendment declaring that, to protect human life, a right to abortion and funding of abortion shall **not** be found in the Louisiana Constitution?” **If passed**, the Love Life Amendment would place this language in the Louisiana Constitution ensuring the judges **could never** declare a “right to abortion: in Louisiana. This is necessary because the supreme courts of 13 states, including New York and even Kansas, have “found” a right to abortion in their constitutions, reinforcing an abortion-on-demand policy.

Mass Overflow in the School Gym

In case we reach church occupancy capacity we have decided to set-up an overflow room in the school gym. If and when the Church reaches capacity, the ushers will direct the faithful to the gym where they can participate in the Mass via livestream. This will assure that no one who comes for Mass will have to be turned away. Communion will be brought to those in the gym by an Extraordinary Minister of Communion at the regular time.

CONFIRMATION - Week #4 on October 18th we took a temperament personality test to better understand who we are and who God is. Next week on October 25th we will have a SPONSOR Sunday where Confirmation candidates and their sponsors could spend time together in prayer and talking about their Catholic faith in preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
