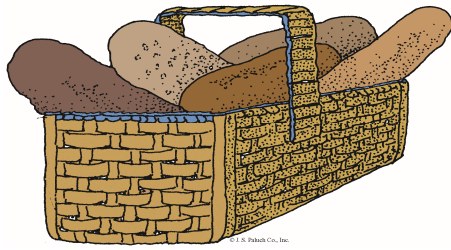

## Virtual Ignatian Year Event Pilgrimage Stop: Grand Coteau

*“Tracing the Footprints of God”*

This past May the Society of Jesus opened an Ignatian Year commemorating the conversion that transformed St. Ignatius’ life – a conversion initiated by the injury Ignatius suffered at the battle of Pamplona (ie. his *“cannonball moment”*). Fr. Arturo Sosa, SJ – Superior General of the Society of Jesus – invites us in the year ahead to pray for conversion so that we might hear more clearly Jesus’ call in the midst of the *“cannonball moments”* of our world today.

On Thursday, August 12th, Father Provincial of the Jesuits, Fr. Tom Greene, SJ invites you to join him in the first of four prayer evenings. Gathering Jesuits, lay coworkers and collaborators, and friends of the Society of Jesus through Zoom, Fr. Greene, SJ will set the context for the Society’s mission in South Louisiana and then invite us to pray together as he celebrates mass. Fr. Mark Thibodeaux, SJ – a Jesuit from Church Point, Louisiana – will offer a reflection on the Ignatian Pathway to God and then send all participants into small group conversations. The hope in these conversations is to grow in our awareness of God’s active presence in our lives and to begin a discernment on how God is inviting us to respond generously.
