Holy Family has been asked to participate in the **Kairos Program** at the Lima Correctional Institute again this year.

**Kairos** is an ecumenical Christian ministry designed for use in correctional institutions. The ministry is conducted, in cooperation with the chaplain of the facility, by a team of laity and clergy who are qualified by their experiences in Christian renewal. The purpose of Kairos is to help build and nurture a strong Christian community among the residents on the inside.

So how is Holy Family participating in Kairos?

**Holy Family** will participate in this ministry by baking 3600 (300 dozen) **cookies\*** for the **Kairos Weekend Retreat** being held at the Allen Oakwood Correctional Institution, Lima OH., coming up on the weekend of Nov. 3rd, 4th & 6th.

**\*Due to the very stringent guidelines on baking these cookies, it has been decided that we (Holy Family) will purchase Chocolate Chip frozen cookie dough. Two of our parishioners and their employers have offered to bake and package them for us.**

Parishioners may participate in this project by making a donation to help the cover the cost of the cookie dough.
