### Instant potatoes & pork & Beans

Last weekend (Dec. 14th & 15th) 2-26.7 oz boxes of instant mashed potatoes, 4-14.5 oz cans of chicken broth, 15 various size cans and brands of pork & beans, 4-10.5 oz cans of condensed cream of mushroom soup, 2-10.5 oz can of condensed cream of chicken soup, 3-16 oz boxes of Penne Rigate, 2-16 oz boxes of elbow macaroni, 4-16oz boxes of Rotelle, 6-7.5oz boxes of macaroni & cheese dinner mix, 1-12.3 oz of 10 packets of fruit & cream flavored variety packets of instant oat meal, 2-4oz pouches of "four cheese" instant mashed potato mix, 2-4oz pouches of "creamy butter" instant mashed potato mix, and 2-4oz pouches of "loaded" instant mashed potato mix were collected and taken to the NB Food Pantry.
