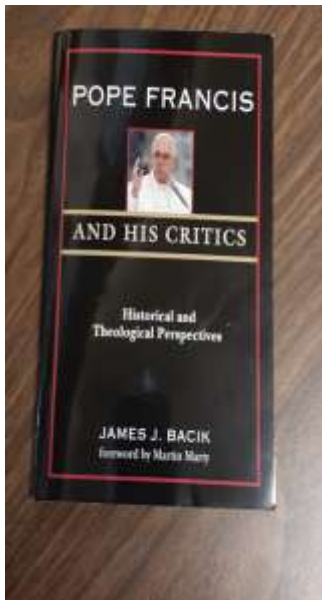
The 2019 contribution statements are now available for pick up in the church vestibule.
