Last weekend (Feb. 1st & 2nd) 1-18oz bottle of barbeque sauce, 1- 24oz jar of sandwich dill chips, 1- 8oz jar of apple butter, 1-16oz box of elbow macaroni, 2-16 oz boxes of "thin" spaghetti, 1-16 oz jar of creamy peanut butter, 1- 40 oz jar of creamy peanut butter, 1- 48 oz jar of creamy peanut butter, 2- 12.5 oz cans of chunk chicken breast, 2- 5oz cans of chunk light tuna in water, 2- 4.8 oz boxes of sour cream & chive potatoes mix 1- 16 oz box of lasagna noodles, 3- 24 oz jars of "organic" olive oil, basil & garlic pasta sauce, 2-24 oz cans of traditional pasta sauce, 2- 24 oz jars of tomato basil pasta sauce, 2- 23.75 oz jars of chunky garden combo pasta sauce, 4-15 oz jars of alfredo sauce, 8- 24 oz jars of applesauce, 4- 24 oz jars of cinnamon applesauce, 2-15 oz cans of "lite" sliced peaches, 1-14.5 oz can of sliced peaches, 12-15oz cans of sliced peaches, 12-15 oz cans of mandarin oranges, and 1-10 oz bag of "salt & vinegar" potato chips were collected and taken to the NB Food Pantry.
