Introduction to the liturgy of the Day

At our Baptism we were told, "you have become a new creation and have clothed yourself in Christ." Each Sunday we come here a new creation, transformed even, if we are not conscious of it. Baptism has created us anew, has given us new life. Also, no matter what we may be wearing, we are clothed in Christ. In what we do and what others see, we hope to show that we have put on Christ. On this feast of the Baptism of the Lord, let us appreciate the new creation we have become.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Isaiah 55:1-11 *Come to the water.*

Isaiah 12 *"You will drawn joyfully from the springs of salvation."*

1 John 5:1-9 *To love God is to keep God's commandments.*

Mark 1:7-11 *The spirit of God descends like a dove.*

Isaiah proclaims the Lord's invitation: "All you who are thirsty, come to the water." John the Baptist invites everyone to come to the water as well, but tells them that the one who is coming will baptize with the Holy Spirit. John tells us that the Spirit testifies to the truth. Reborn in the waters of baptism and filled with spirit, we listen to God's word searching for the truth.
