John 12:26

**Whoever serves me must follow me,
says the Lord; and where I am,
there also will my servant be.**

Introduction to the liturgy of the Day

During Lent our Lord call us to make a conversion of the heart. Many can show us the way, but then it's up to **us** to commit to Christ's mission. As we approach the days in which we remember Jesus suffering and death, we ask ourselves if we are willing to resolve to die to sin and live faithfully, selflessly and courageously in the Lord.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Jeremiah 31:31-34 *I will make a new covenant and remember their sin no more.*

Psalms 51 *"Create a clean heart in me, O God."*

Hebrews 5:7-9 *Christ learned obedience and became the source of eternal salvation.*

John 12:20-23 *If a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it produces much fruit.*

Jeremiah sets the tone for today's readings when he writes that the Lord promises a new covenant. The old covenant was external: the Chosen People were led by the hand. But the new covenant is internal, written upon our hearts. As Christians, we believe that the new covenant is fulfilled in God's son, who came into our hearts at baptism, who animates our lives, and who can be found in those we meet. Can we be like a grain of wheat, alive in the Lord, producing much fruit?
