**Important Announcement**

Together, the Bishops of Ohio have decided that the general obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (including the Saturday/Vigil Mass) is to be **reinstated. This will take effect in the Dioceses of Ohio the weekend of June 5/6, 2021.**

As has always been the case, those who are ill, have significant health risk factors or care for someone who is immuno-compromised or ill, are exempt from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, **as well as those who have significant fear or anxiety of contracting the Corona Virus in a large group of persons (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2181).**

**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day**

"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." We say this when we enter church, when we begin Mass, when we pray. It is our identity. It reminds us that we are in the presence of God. It joins us to millions of other Christians across time and space. It expresses our belief in the Triune God. Three persons in one God enabled God to become incarnate, enabled God to come down upon us in baptism, and enables God to be with us here today and every day. Let us contemplate the great wonders God has done and continues to do in our daily lives.

**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word**

**Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40**

*The Lord is the God in the heavens above and on earth below and there is no other.*

**Psalms 33** *"Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own."*

**Corinthians Roman 8:14-17**

*You received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, "Abba, Father!"*

**Matthew 28:16-20**

*Baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.*

As he says farewell to his disciples, Jesus instructs them to baptize "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

Nearly twenty full centuries later we were baptized with the same words. God the Father, whom Moses extols in the first reading, God the Son, who calls us to discipleship in the Gospel, and God the Holy Spirit, whom Paul says bears witness to our adoption as children of God, mark our identity as Christians. We are reminded of this every time we make the sign of the cross. Listening to God's Holy Word, let us reflect on the blessings we receive from the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
