**32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time cont'd**

**The Second Reading**, from the **Letter to the Hebrews, 9:24-28** *Christ was offered once to take away the sins of many.*

**The Gospel, Mark 12:38 or 12:41-44**

*This poor widow put in more than all the others.*

The readings today focus on two women whose powerful faith sustains them in their grief. Though we know very little about their backgrounds, both women are widows, so they have lost their husbands, bringing both emotional and financial pain. One woman has no food but a handful of four and a little oil. The other has no money but two coins. Yet each is willing to offer what little she has to God's work. The sacrifice each makes portends the sacrifice Christ himself makes on the cross for us all.
