**Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word**

**The First Reading** is from the **Book of the Prophet Micah 5:1-4a**

*From Bethlehem shall come the ruler of Israel.*

**Psalm 80** "Lord, make us turn to you; let us see your face and we shall be saved."

**The Second Reading** is from the **Letter to the Hebrews 10:5-10** *Behold, I come to do your will.*

**Gospel of Luke 1-39-45** *Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth.*

Our anticipation of the Lord's birth is mirrored in the words from scripture that we hear today. Micah, who lived eight centuries before Jesus was born, proclaims the long-awaited ruler from the line of David will come from the little town of Bethlehem. The author of Hebrews asserts that Jesus was born into the world to be himself an offering according to the Father's will. Luke tells the story of Mary visiting her older cousin Elizabeth, who filled with the Holy Spirit, becomes the first to call her blessed. Filled with the Holy Spirit let us focus our anticipation on God's blessings.
