

6TH ELA GRADE STUDY GUIDE 2020

Topics will include:

- Vocabulary words
- Greek and Latin Roots/affixes and their meanings
- Word analysis (context clues from vocal words)
- Grammar
- Analyze how a particular sentence, chapter, scene, or stanza fits into the overall structure of a text and contributes to the development of the theme, setting, or plot.
- Cite textual evidence to support analysis of what the text says explicitly as well as inferences drawn from the text.
- Determine a theme or central idea of a text and how it is conveyed through particular details; provide a summary of the text distinct from personal opinions or judgments.
- Determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text, including figurative and connotative meanings; analyze the impact of a specific word choice on meaning and tone.
- Determine or clarify the meaning of unknown and multiple-meaning words and phrases based on grade 6 reading and content, choosing flexibly from a range of strategies.
- Use context (e.g., the overall meaning of a sentence or paragraph; a word's position or function in a sentence) as a clue to the meaning of a word or phrase.
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- Demonstrate understanding of figurative language, word relationships, and nuances in word meanings.
- Use the relationship between particular words (e.g., cause/effect, part/whole, item/category) to better understand each of the words
- Write narratives to develop real or imagined experiences or events using effective technique, relevant descriptive details, and well-structured event sequences.

- Use narrative techniques, such as dialogue, pacing, and description, to develop experiences, events, and/or characters.
- Provide a conclusion that follows from the narrated experiences or events.
- Produce clear and coherent writing in which the development, organization, and style are appropriate to task, purpose, and audience.

Students will use the quizlet vocab link for their grade located on class pages and the pdf notes to study roots and affixes and practice grammar. Students will refer to grammar sentence corrections in their notebooks.

Students will practice reading and writing strategies listed above with a reading comprehension passage. Short answer topics and unknown word strategies will be reviewed in class
