Dear Holy Rosary School Families,

As you know, we continue to make plans for our reopening date of September 9, 2020, for both our in person and remote instruction. I am grateful for your patience as we work to make sure that our school is safe and that we are ready to implement a successful learning experience this year. We all know that things are not yet “back to normal” but we have made it this far and have overcome many challenges over the past 5 months. With God’s blessings and strength, we will continue to move forward as we begin the new school year.

Over the past few weeks, I have spoken with many of our families to answer a variety of questions regarding the upcoming school year. I am happy to have these individual conversations as it helps both the school and our families to become more comfortable as we move forward with our plans. We are also able to schedule a Zoom meeting as well. I would ask that you please email the school and we will set up a date/time for either an in-person call, an in person visit or a Zoom. We are able to have school tours on a limited basis, please just contact us in advance to make an appointment.

Our first days of school are scheduled for September 9th and 10th with September 11th as a conference day. There will be no instruction this day to allow staff and faculty to review the first 2 days of school and plan for any adjustments needed for our first full week of classes beginning 9/14. Next week we will send out information on entrance procedures and protocols for in person instruction, as well as login information for our remote learners.

Our supply list this year will be simple to start the year and supplies for both in person and remote instruction:

Kindergarten: 1 box of crayons, one box of colored pencils, regular pencils, 2 two-pocket folders (bookbag, and pencil case for in person)

Grades 1, 2, 3: 1 box of crayons, one box of colored pencils, regular pencils, 6 wide rule notebooks, ruler, loose-leaf paper, 2 two-pocket folders, glue stick, scissors (bookbag, and pencil case for in person)

Grades 4, 5, 6, 7, 8: 1 box of crayons, one box of colored pencils, 1 set of markers, regular pencils and pens, glue stick, highlighter, scissors, protractor, 8 notebooks, 8 two-pocket folders (bookbag, and pencil case for in person)

Please feel free to call me or email with any questions or concerns. My goal, and that of our faculty and staff, is to provide as much support as needed to have a smooth and successful start to the school year, for both our in person and our remote learners. This is yet another “new experience in 2020” for us all and by praying to our Lord and working together, we know that we will move forward through this challenge.
