### Financial Report -

- The candy bar sales, World's Finest Chocolate, received positive feedback. The kids love it. They only cost \$1 and are easy to sell.
- We only have 42 boxes left out of 230, 30 were free to help pay for incentives and prizes to kids.
- \$6095 expenses already paid for by PTO,

- \$28,998.62 total in checking account
- \$8888 in Savings - Father to get us an updated balance on this.

### Old Business-

- Destiny Quest needs voted on now, as the bill is due.
- E-rate matching fund update - Still not getting a response from parties involved.

### New Business-

- Projector and shredder purchase was approved by the executive committee and the cost was under \$595.28. Projector is in, wireless not as nice as hoped, but the mobility of wireless is nice. The shredder not in yet
- PTO Officers for 2019-2020 school year - Vice president will not take over for president next year as normal due to too many commitments. Keeli Montgomery will be taking over as President. We will need a new vice-president and secretary. If anybody knows someone who is interested, please have them contact the pto and be in attendance at the May meeting, when we are voting
- Teacher Appreciation Day will be on Tuesday, May 7th. The PTO will provide lunch. We will need volunteers to run lunch and recess so teachers can gather. We will need gifts. Rebecca Bergkamp will be willing to organize events for the entire week. Pam's was very good, would recommend using her again for the meal. We can use sign up genius for volunteers. Would like to get teachers some laptop bags this year. Christal might be able to do it and put names on laptop bags or backpacks. 11 staff members \$550 for gifts and \$200 for lunch - \$750 total
- Father not happy with PTO having too many fundraisers. Thinks parents should help pay for fundraisers. Can PTO cut back on budget and not have a golf tournament going forward? Maybe cut back on licenses. He doesn't like the license for the library.
- Battle of the Books t-shirts - Will PTO pay for Battle of the Book T-Shirts? The school needs 13 shirts. We could get Christel to make shirts at maybe \$12 per shirt.
- New Math Series for 2019-2020 school year is not chosen yet. The price ranges from \$30,000 \$20,000 or \$10,000 for a five year deal. Mr. Butler would hate to lock in on high price if it doesn't work well. He doesn't know anybody who is using it. Butler would recommend we get 2 year deal so we can change if we don't like it. They are subscriptions and consumables for K to 8th. Going to see if they can give us a group discount. \$10,000 is for the Eureka Math which is being used by USD470 and our teachers are leaning this way. Not sure of what we are going to do? Grant is due in June, wondering if we can use the Westminster grant to pay for it? Could add the needed Chromebooks for first grade to the grant. PTO could prepay and then cover if grant doesn't go through.
