- **Pastor’s Update:**
  1. St. Patrick/St. Joseph Dinner Dance was a great success in so many ways for the parish. Many thanks for the donation of nearly \$5000 as well as gift to the St. Jude’s Hospital.
  2. LADIES ONLY day of Recollection was wel-received with 47 ladies on re-treat at the Sisters of Life Retreat House in Connecticut.
  3. Saturday adult classes in March were attended by 10 to 12 parishioners and the priest were pleased with the response.
  4. Adult classes are planned for the 5 Tuesdays in May at 7pm. The topic is the Mass and the presenter will be Mrs. Theresa Falciano.
  5. The region has hired a director of maintenance for the school. His name is Mr. Alonzo Carr. Thanks to Mr. and Mrs. Heany for their recommendation.
  6. Simple landscaping, mulching, and tree trimming has begun
  7. The Holy Week Schedule is finished; preparations are underway; Reconciliation Monday is next week –April 10 from 4:30pm to 7:30pm.
  8. The Cardinal’s appeal continues to move towards the goal of \$57,500 – nearly 60% there with 110 donors.

9. First confession was held on Saturday for the children of the elementary school at 12 noon with about 32 students and at 2pm for the religious education students with about 25 students.
10. A Holy Hour sponsored by the Archdiocesan Young Adults Office will be held here on Friday April 28 at 7pm; our own Teen Group will be on retreat April 21, 22, and 23.
11. All parishes have participated in or will be participating in A MAJOR FUND RAISING CAMPAIGN for the parish with most of the funds remaining in the parish for improvements. We will be asked to participate within the next few months. I am handling out a list of some projects to be done.

6. Removal of wooden altar piece on cafeteria stage - \$3600
7. Removal of marble altar - \$7500
8. Renovation of the de Chantal Hall (including a prep kitchen, two bathrooms) - \$250,000
9. Additional landscaping and tree care - \$5000
10. Cafeteria sound system – 2 bids - \$8000 and \$6000
11. Cement work/drainage/walkway – Msgr. Halpin Way to Harding Ave. \$20,000
12. School Emergency Lights/Exit Lights \$20,000
13. School Boiler Room Electrical Panel \$25000
14. Rectory renovations – to be determined
