- **Pastor's Update:**
  1. End of the year Mass with students in their robes (kindergarten Graduation, 1st Communion, Confirmation, 8th grade Graduation) on June 13.
  2. Graduation Ceremony on June 15 in the Church
  3. Bishop Matthew invited back to celebrate 2018 Confirmation
  4. CCD registration is underway; high school program is being offered.
  5. HN Society provided a \$250 prize to two altar servers.
  6. Corpus Christi Mass and Procession with Benediction on June 18.
  7. Marriage Anniversaries were celebrated on June 25 in English and Spanish.
  8. Official beginning and Initiation on 17 ladies in the Sacred Heart Society on June 23; reception on June 25.
  9. Electrical panel in the boiler room of the school is being repaired over the next few weeks; sketches have been finished, physical work to begin, tree will be removed so that the electric line can come into the school, cost is about \$75,000.
  10. Summer maintenance of the school has started (floors, painting, repairs, etc.); cafeteria kitchen to be painted; the pooling of water in the alley way between Harding and Msgr. Halpin place seems to be fixed because of the extra drains and cement work.
  11. Three overhang roofs at school entrances/exits are being repaired and replaced, cost is about \$10,000.
  12. Anniversary plans are moving ahead with Marie and Christi; Journal Committee is hard at work (very important fundraiser).
  13. Summer celebrations: Carnival (July 19 to 23); Paint and Dessert Nigh (August 12).
  14. Life Screening event for August 12 (Registration is required; discount of \$25 for the first 7 people to register)
  15. HNS Summer Blood Drive for Sunday August 6
  16. New Principal for the School. Sister Patricia Brito started already. Ms. Grace Lucie retired. A number of candidates were interviewed by regional, Msgr. Graham, Maryanne Keeney, among others. Sister Patricia has years of experience as a teacher and principal. Her extensive experience in Catholic Education it is welcomed at our school. Currently there is no assistant principal in the school. Enrollment at this point is 334 students. The school does not have a security guard. The city provides funds for this.
