Notes (Minutes)

- Pastor's Update:
 1. A new landscaping service was hired. They are going to work on the School and Rectory entrance.
 2. New work with concrete on the sidewalk of the property was delayed because of the weather. A new date was set to start by Thursday.
 3. A contract was signed with boiler maintenance. They are in charge of maintaining the boiler and AC throughout the year.
 4. Ushers are very important to the liturgy. They bring to the attention of the priest those who are disabled and they help in the collection among other things. Head Ushers are Mr. Jack Lynch, Barney and Frank.
 5. We are training new lectors and new Eucharist ministers. On Sunday the Blood of Christ was made available and went well. There was only one minor issue and the usher brought it to my attention and I took care of it.
 6. School children will be attending mass on a regular basis. Religion Education starts tomorrow. There were 160 kids in CCD last year. So far there are about 60 but we expect more.
 7. I am going to continue talking politely about leaving early and coming late to mass.
- Reconstitution of the Parish Council:

There needs to be a parish council. Ex-Officio members are automatically part of the council. I would like to appoint more members. I will establish the official Parish Council by January 2017. I will put an ad in the parish bulletin asking for more members. We will probably need a nominating committee to select new members.

- Possibilities for the Parking Lot:
Maria Brogli did lots of work on this. This is a 40 year old problem. Marie prepared an entire package with details. We could request a donation but it may open up us to liabilities. We are going to put up signs that state "Private Property no trespassing, towed at your own expense". The Archdiocese suggested not asking for money. There are about 60 cars parked during the day and 40 that are there all the time.
- Plans for the Information Societies Weekend:
We are going to have our different societies represented. Each society will have a table that will provide information about their organization. This is an opportunity for recruitment. Weather permitting we are going to have it outside in the church plaza from Saturday after 5pm mass through Sunday after 1pm mass.
- Plans for the 90th Anniversary:
We need a couple of committees. Committees such as Religious, Social, Journal, Dinner & Dance. We need to think of the various activities to do.
- Parish Website: It is now online. Send any suggestions to Jonathan.
- Youth Group: Youth group started on Sunday and the lipstick competition is set for 12/3/2016
- New Business: Someone made a donation of \$300 to the nocturnal adoration which it is going to be used to do the mailing. One suggestion about Nocturnal Adoration that it may end at 12am and begin again at 5am.
- Holy Name Society Executive Meeting is set for November 5 at 11am in the meeting room.
