- **SFDC Capital Campaign:** Samantha Noble, representative of the Archdiocese Capital Campaign was the main speaker to address the Parish Council. The Capital Campaign for SFDC will start Feb/March. The goal is \$800,000. The pledges are paid in a five-year period. 73% of the Capital Campaign will stay with SFDC to be utilized for capital improvements to the properties. On the first year the Cardinal's appeal will be part of the Capital Campaign. SFDC is in Block 4 of the Campaign.

1. Recruit a strong campaign Chairperson
2. Create a committee of volunteers
3. Secure gifts in a timely manner.
4. Announce the campaign when the parish has secured 65% of the goal (\$520,000)
