- **Pastors Reports:**

Renew and Rebuild has officially ended. There were 168 donors with pledges of \$727,535.00. So far \$193,043.48 has been paid. Our account has received \$19,000 thus far. The new bathrooms, new kitchenette and extension of the wall has been paid for from these funds. Many Thanks.

The Cardinal's Annual Stewardship Appeal for 2019 has begun. The 2019 goal is again \$73,000. Almost \$10,000 has been pledged/paid.

Monsignor thanked the people in the parish for all the things they have contributed to.

First Penance for elementary school was February 2nd. First Penance for CCD is March 23rd.

Family Faith Formation days, mandated by the Archdiocese, meet with Msgr. Graham and Sr. Pat for 10 am Mass and family activity afterwards. Religious Ed program meets with Msgr. Graham and Ms. Christi. The CCD catechists are taking 8 hours of class with Msgr. And Fr. Robert.

Lenten schedule is in the bulletin. On April 12, 2019 the Stations of the Cross will be bi-lingual and will be the Stations through the eyes of Mary. 14 volunteer women will read the stations.

The day of Recollection for Women will be on March 20th.

Holy Hour conducted by the Sisters of Life will be conducted on Friday April 5th.

The area Revival is April 9-10-11.

The Anointing of the Sick Mass is scheduled for June 8th.

Fr. Dennis coordinated a training program of new lectors and E.M.'s. They were commissioned and will begin service in March. We will now have 4 ministers and 2 priests for the 1 pm Spanish Mass.

The St. Valentines Dance was successful.

Questions were asked concerning the sound system. Marge Weihler and Herberto Diaz will meet with a company to see what could be done to address the issues.

- **Liturgy Report (Margie DiSilvio):** The S/L Committee is going to have a Mass of the Anointing. The mass is on June 8th.
- **Area Revival/Evangelization:** The Mission/Revival will be on April 9-10-11, 2019. The members of the clergy have been scheduled. Donations are being asked for. The English Prayer Group, CYO, HNS, Rainbow club have all donated cash to the revival. Sign up sheets are available for anyone who wishes to help speak at the masses in other parishes. Each parish donated \$300 toward the food budget. The Priests stipend has been donated by the Archdiocese. The money that was left from last year will pay for the musicians on the first 2 nights. Tables will be set up, like last year, on the last night. The Youth Ministry from the Archdiocese may come.

On Saturday February 9th, Ed Green was presenting a 2 hour talk on How to do Evangelizing. All are welcome. Also the Nuns of Immaculate Mary teach – How to do Home Visits, door to door.
- **SFDC School (Sister Patricia Brito):** 28 students made 1st Penance. International day at the school with costumes and food will be held in the cafeteria on Sunday March 31st. Tables will be set and displayed in DeChantal Hall. The Lent activities include the children going to the 9am Mass with Ashes. They will do church visits, grades 2 and up, for a few minutes to say a prayer. Confessions are scheduled. Grade 3/4/5 will do Stations of the Cross.

We were approved for 2 Pre-K3 classes and may have 3. (3/4 year old's go to Pre-K free to help the parents understand the importance of education. We will be adding a second Kindergarten Class in September. A large group will be marching in the St. Patrick's Day Parade on March 10th. (Maryanne Keeney) – School Bingo is May 17th in Dechantal hall – any and all donations are being accepted as prizes. Prior bingos have paid for Ipads, Electricity, flooring and other things in the school. The second kids version was held Aand it went very well.
- **Social Activities:** The Choir is hosting the annual St Patrick – St Joseph concert on St. Patrick's Day- March 17th at 3:30 p.m. The St. Patrick's/St Joseph's dance is March 8th. A good turnout is expected based on ticket sales. A question was tossed out in regard to having the American Bombshells return on June 29th. A positive response was received and a suggestion of more advertising was made. Use of flyers in the bulletin and through the school.
