- **Pledge of Allegiance:** All
- **Minutes Approval - Approved**
- **Pastors Reports:** Renew and Rebuild has pledges of \$744165.00. So far \$210,148.40 has been paid. Our account has received \$70,000 thus far. The bathrooms, kitchenette, wall extension, and the school conference room renovation have been paid from these funds. We are awaiting proposal for additional cement work and HVAC system.
 - The Cardinal's Annual Stewardship Appeal goal is again \$73,000. Almost \$22,000 has been pledged/paid from 102 donors. A second letter will be going out to parishioners.
 - The day of Recollection for Women was well received with 52 participants. A \$600 donation was made to the Sisters of Life.
 - The area Revival preparations are on schedule. Many thanks to the many volunteers. The Archdiocese contributed \$3000, each parish donated \$300 & several donations from parish societies & parishioners.
 - Maritime College was visited & showed interest to be of service to the young people at the parish.
 - The sound system issue was addressed with several companies consulted...more to come.
 - Reconciliation Monday is April 15th
 - Stations of the cross through the eyes of Mary will be held Friday April 12th.
- **Liturgy Report (Margie DiSilvio):** The S/L Committee is going to have a Mass of the Anointing. The Mass is on June 8th.
- **Area Revival/Evangelization:** The Priests stipend has been donated by the Archdiocese. The money that was left from last year will pay for the musicians on the first 2 nights. The Youth Ministry from the Archdiocese may come.
 - In May a meeting will be set Re: house-to-house ministry with training by LAMP.
- **SFDC School (Sister Patricia Brito):** We were approved for 2 Pre-K3 classes. Cleaning/Painting to get ready for the summer is in the process. We are trying to build up the middle school
- **New Business:** The Young Teen Group will do the living stations of the cross on Good Friday (4/19) at 8 PM.
 - The English Prayer group will be selling palm crosses all weekend. The crosses are \$10 each.
 - The annual men's retreat at Bishop Malloy's Retreat House is May 3-4-5.
