Incoming 6th Grade Summer Reading Assignment

Book: Shiloh by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor

Due Date: Tuesday, September 14, 2021

Directions: Please read the required summer reading book, *Shiloh* by Phyllis Reynolds Naylor and complete the assignment.

Assignment: Marty feels very strongly that it takes the right kind of person to care for a dog properly. Marty does not believe that Judd Travers is capable of taking care of a dog. First, make a list of 10 reasons that Marty has for believing that Judd Travers is not the right kind of person to own an animal. Then, complete the following project about taking care of a pet.

Questions:

Step One: Choose an animal that you would like to have as a pet but have never had the opportunity to own. Find out all you can about the pet.

Step Two: Research what the animal eats and how much it would cost to feed it for a year.

Step Three: Research the type of medical care that your animal will need:

1) Calculate the type of preventative care that it will need. (For example, dogs need rabies shots, heartworm pills, and flea prevention medication.)

2) Research the types of medical problems that your pet may have and then calculate how much a veterinary bill would be to treat those illnesses.

Step Four: Research the type of shelter your animal will need.

Step Five: Create a list of proper techniques for caring for the pet.

Step Six: Create a google slide/PowerPoint that provides all of the information a person would need for owning the pet that you have chosen. Your Google Slide/ PowerPoint should be neat and colorful.
