


CEDAR POINT

PHYSICS, MATH, AND SCIENCE DAY

Carefully read all parts.

What: Cedar Point's Physics, Math, and Science day provides students an opportunity to experience the laws of physics in motion firsthand, and learn how they were used to create the rides and experiences of Cedar Point.



When: Wednesday May 13th

Cost: Approximately \$50

** This cost is an approximation. This value will change, depending on the responses to this form. Final values will be announced once all forms have been filled out and returned.

Cost Breakdown:

- \$40
 - Cost of admittance for the event.
 - ** If your child has a Cedar Point Season Pass (i.e. Season Pass, Gold Pass, and Platinum Pass), you will not have to pay this amount.
- \$11
 - Cost of transportation (see back).
 - The price for two buses will be spread between the students attending
 - ** Depending on the final amount of attendants, as per this form, this value may change.

Cost Refunds: If a student fails to meet the academic and behavioral criteria listed on the back of this form, and has already paid, then the cost of admittance will be refunded. ** **The cost of transportation will NOT be refunded.**

When final costs are announced, all funds are due by Friday, May 1st.

The cost does not include food. Bring money to buy food separately.

Transportation:

- Two rented school buses will transport students to and from Cedar Point.
- Students are **NOT** allowed to drive themselves.
- Students **MUST** take the bus to and from Cedar Point.
- If a student wishes to, they may have a parent pick them up with prior approval and appropriate circumstance. Otherwise, they will take the bus.

Times:

- Students will board the buses starting at 8:15, and depart Elyria Catholic at 8:30.
- On the return trip, one bus will leave at 4pm, and the other at 7pm.
 - *Due to limits of seating, students must select and commit to one of the two departure times listed below.*
- ** These times are final, as they determine the cost of transportation listed on the front.

Academic and Behavioral Criteria:

Students must meet the following criteria to attend the trip. If a student breaks one of the criteria, their privilege to attend the trip will be revoked.

- No non-dress code related detentions for Semester 2, 2020
- Obtain a quarter 3 grade of C or higher for Physics.
- Have fewer than 5 disruptive warnings for semester 2.
 - These warnings are given if a student is being a disruption to class activities (i.e. talking when another is talking), or not being on task when working on an assignment.
