Lorain County Community College – Summer/Fall Semesters 2020

Colleges/universities cannot test new students for summer term enrollment for eligibility and admission consideration due to shut down of campuses, Accuplacer and ACT/SAT testing. As this disruption is occurring during our enrollment cycle for both summer and fall semester, we will apply these multiple measures for both summer and fall enrollment timeframe for admission, enrollment and placement.

In order to meet student eligibility requirements, a student shall have an overall high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.0, if that prospective College Credit Plus (CCP) student has not had the opportunity to complete an assessment exam due to this emergency. 2. If a prospective CCP student had previously completed an assessment exam and did not meet student eligibility requirements based on those scores, a college can consider that student as eligible if the student has an overall high school grade point average of 3.0. 3. The institution of higher education still has the opportunity to use institutional standards for admission decisions and placement into courses. 4. Colleges shall collect data related to the multiple measures used in anticipation of reporting to the CCP Data Portal. 5. Once the student has been determined as eligible, has been admitted, and has enrolled in summer and/or fall term courses, the student remains eligible for the remainder of their participation in the program. There is no need to re-test for eligibility purposes. 	<p>For summer and fall terms 2020:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Admit current students as CCP students who have an overall high school GPA of 3.0 or higher if student has not had the opportunity to assess. 2. If a prospective CCP student had previously completed an assessment and did not meet student eligibility requirements based on those scores, LCCC shall consider that student as eligible if the student has an overall high school grade point average of 3.0. 3. For English placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admitted CCP students with a 3.0 unweighted GPA and a writing sample of 7 or higher shall be eligible to enroll in ENGL 161 – College Composition • Admitted CCP students with a 3.0 unweighted GPA and 4 completed semesters of high school coursework are exempt from completing the Writing Sample 4. Colleges shall collect data related to the multiple measures used in anticipation of reporting to the CCP Data Portal. 5. Once the CCP student has been determined as eligible, has been admitted, and has enrolled in summer and/or fall term courses, the student remains eligible for the remainder of their participation in the program. There is no need to re-test for eligibility purposes. 6. When Accuplacer, ACT and SAT become available online, CCP applicants with below a 3.0 GPA may be offered the opportunity to asses for further consideration of eligibility. Normal measures are then applied.
