FOOD PANTRY- Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

****Covid-19 Support- Special Distribution****

Is the pantry only available to residents of Sheffield or Sheffield Lake?

No. While the target population is within this geographic area, this distribution is open to any resident of Lorain County.

Do you have to have kids within the schools in order to participate?

No. This food pantry is open to the entire community for those in need, regardless of whether they have kids who attend the Sheffield Schools.

Do I need to bring a pay stub or proof of income?

No. While you must be income eligible in order to receive food support (refer to the table on the reverse side of this flyer—note that these guidelines are based on income as of right now...you may be in need due to a layoff or reduction in hours due to the coronavirus). Proof of income or documentation is not required.

What do I need to do on the day of the pantry?

Please make sure the trunk of your vehicle is empty, clean, and ready to load. If your trunk is not empty, you will be asked to leave and empty your trunk. Second Harvest is incorporating social distancing and "No Touch" practices to keep your families and our communities safe! Please follow directions of the police and national guard.

Are there limits on how many items that can be taken?

This is a special distribution. It will consist of pre-packed boxes and there will be some extra items (meat, eggs, vegetables depending on availability).

I want to participate, but I am unable to attend during the allotted time OR I am not feeling well. Is there anything I can do?

Yes. You are able to designate a proxy (someone who is able to pick-up items on your behalf). The person who is unable to attend (elderly, shut-in, or those with scheduling or mobility issues) should fill out the "Eligibility to Take Food Home Form-Letter of Proxy."
