**OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING  
OF THE UNIVERSE**

**First Reading: 2 Samuel 5: 1-3**

Samuel describes how all the tribes of Israel went to David in Hebron and said they were his bone and his flesh and it was he who led them back to Israel. The Lord told David he would be a shepherd to His people. David made an agreement with the elders and was anointed king.

**Second Reading: Colossians 1: 12-20**

Paul explains to the Colossians that God has made them fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light and that through the Son we have redemption and forgiveness of sin. He describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God, the head of the church and in Him all things hold together.

**Gospel: Luke 23: 35-43**

Jesus is mocked by the crowd as he hung on the cross. Above him was an inscription that read: This is the King of Jews." One of the men being crucified with Jesus tells Him to save them and Himself, while the other asks that he be remembered when Jesus is in his kingdom. Jesus said in reply, "Amen I say to you, you will be with me in Paradise.
