Our Parish Council met on Tuesday, May 8th. Here are few details we discussed and spoke in the meeting.

St. Anthony's Feast: Like every year we will be celebrating St. Anthony's Feast this year on Sunday, June 10th from 12 noon to 5 PM and it will be celebrated in a grand scale this year. Some of the highlights about the feast are; we will have a famous band doing the music, Italian food, games for the kids with so many other activities. Forestburgh Church and the Rectory: Last year, St. Thomas Aquinas church was merged with our Parish. No mass was offered or any other sacraments were administered since the merger happened.
