Dear Parishioners,

Last week on Tuesday, I along with four of our Parishioners attended a FORMED workshop that was held in John Burke High School in Goshen. You can find the details of formed website in the next page. To know more about this I invite all of you to come and join us for a workshop “**GOD ONLINE**” that will be held in our Parish Center on Sunday from 2 PM to 4 PM. I will write more about this in the next week bulletin. Meantime please consider attending this workshop without absence. This will help you and your family to connect to God.

Next week, I will be speaking at all of the Masses and formally announce the Renew + Rebuild Campaign here at St. Anthony of Padua and St. Thomas Aquinas Church. Again, Renew + Rebuild is an aggressive \$200 million Diocesan campaign aimed at providing financial support to parishes to help ensure their growth and sustainability. \$144 million of the funds raised in this campaign will be directed to parishes to address their own local concerns. Here at our parish, we identified several important large projects that will be addressed through this effort, namely, renovating the ramp at the side door of our Church, putting heating system in our Sacred Heart Mission Church, Pond Eddy, taking care of the mold in our Church, Repairing our Pavilion, and so many other important works in the Church that needs our immediate attention.

Every parish in the archdiocese will participate in this campaign. Each parish has their own goal. Each parish will keep 74 cents of every dollar we raise (74 %.). We have many needs at our parish, and I am confident that our parish community can raise \$158,000. I do know that this is a lot of money, but I am very pleased to tell you that we already have few of our Parishioners who positively responded to this Campaign and promised to make Pledges. Thank you. This is incredible!

Since coming here, I have been overwhelmed by the generosity of our parishioners! I support the goals of the Renew + Rebuild campaign and this is a good opportunity for our Parish. We have been blessed by the volunteer support of some of our wonderful parishioners. A small group of dedicated parishioners have signed up to help me with this project. The campaign team members are; Anthony LaRuffa, Pete Scalia, Ron Meyer, Anna Meyer, Jim Rizzi, Nancy Rizzi, and Margie Granese. I am grateful for their leadership and assistance for the benefit of our parish community in this unprecedented effort.
