**FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**First Reading: Isaiah 58:7-10**

This reading is a vigorous exhortation from the prophet Isaiah to lead lives of active charity and generosity. He promises that the Lord will be our “dawn,” our “rear guard,” our “light” if we share our bread, shelter the homeless, and clothe the naked.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:1-5**

Paul tells the Corinthians that he and they must not rely on the so-called “wisdom” of secular teaching and philosophy but on the power of the Spirit.

**Gospel: Matthew 5:13-16**

Jesus reminds the disciples and all Christians that they carry special responsibilities to be “the salt of the earth.” They must not hide their light but show their goodness to all.

## **Dear Friends,**

We are writing to ask you, our parish family, for your help to address an urgent repair that is needed for our water system at St. Anthony's Church Parish Hall. Recently, an inspection revealed that our water is not fit for human consumption.

Our church home, the same as our own homes, requires frequent and expensive maintenance. Here, however, we are also sustaining a spiritual home where each of us is fed by the knowledge of the enduring love of Jesus Christ in our lives. As a parish, we gather to listen to God's word, we feed the hungry, we pray, and we support and uplift each other. When we pray together, we find that our lives are sustained by God's generous spirit. With the donation of your time, talents, and financial support, we maintain our spiritual home at St. Anthony's Church as a sign of our gratitude for God's presence in our lives. At times, emergency expenses arise that we, as a church family, need to work together to fix.

Please consider what you can contribute to help defray the cost of repairing the water system so that we will have safe, potable water in our Parish Hall. Currently, **the estimate for the work to accomplish this is \$7500.** Whatever you are comfortable donating to this project helps all of us to demonstrate the importance of St. Anthony's Parish in our lives.

Below is the itemized estimate we received to complete the necessary work:

**Acid Neutralizer \$2195. 1354ccp**

**Water softener \$3225 s250**

**Ultra-violet \$1895 E4**

**Installation is not included.**

This equipment will improve the overall quality of the water by correcting the acidic/corrosive quality, eliminating/reducing the iron and hardness, and eliminating the bacteria. The existing filter on site is too small but, we can try to make it work with the equipment I am recommending. **The cost for a larger filter is \$395.** There isn't enough space at the location for this equipment at this time. There are recurring costs for maintaining all of this equipment. Please let me know if you want to discuss the plan for reconstructing the utility room/pantry.
