MASS BEGINS

Based upon the good reports from around the archdiocese with the reopening of weekday Mass, baptisms, weddings and funerals, Cardinal Dolan announced that, in the Hudson Valley counties of Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester, Sunday Mass will resume on June 14, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, including the anticipated Mass on Saturday evening.

The solemn obligation to attend Sunday Mass continues to be temporarily suspended, especially for those who feel that they are not ready to come back to church. Those who are at a greater risk of COVID-19 (those older than 65 or who have underlying health conditions) are cautioned not to come to church for Mass. They may join us only when they feel safe and comfortable to do so. As an alternative, Mass may be viewed on line or on TV, and the act of spiritual communion may be used instead of receiving the Eucharist.

EXTRAORDINARY RECONCILIATION FRIDAY

His Eminence is offering our people the opportunity for the sacrament of reconciliation on the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, June 19 from 10-12 and 4-6.
