Gifts of Wisdom

The three Wise Men are depicted in catacomb scenes that show their presence at or shortly after Jesus' birth, which probably gave us that date of January 6. Legends quickly surrounded the travelers. By the sixth century, they got their traditional names, which are probably speculative. Melchior brought Jesus gold to symbolize his kingship. Gaspar brought incense to honor Jesus' divinity. Balthazar offered myrrh, a burial ointment intended to foreshadow Jesus' death and resurrection. One legend says the Wise Men reassembled in Armenia in 54 or 55 to celebrate Christmas and be baptized. They all died soon after: Melchior on January 1 at 116 years old, Balthazar on January 6 at 112, and Gaspar on January 11 at 109. Relics of their bodies were displayed in Persia in 490 and later moved to Constantinople, then to Milan, and then in 1164 to Cologne.
