It was sad that last year we were not able to celebrate Holy Week in person. Thank God we are blessed this year as we have the privilege to celebrate Holy Week in person. Since the spread of Covid still at risk we are instructed by the Archdiocese to follow certain guidelines during the Holy Week. Please carefully read the instructions below and if you have any question, feel free to contact me at any time.

GUIDELINES FOR THE HOLY WEEK

Palm Sunday – March 28

We will celebrate the Lord's Entrance into Jerusalem in our Church without the procession from the Parish Center. The Palms will be blessed beforehand and be distributed to the faithful by the specified ushers, wearing gloves as they enter or exit the church.

Reconciliation Monday – March 29

We will be having our Reconciliation Monday on March 29th from 4 to 7 PM.

Holy Thursday – April 1

The washing of the feet will be omitted on this day. At the end of the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Blessed Sacrament will be kept in the tabernacle. Like all the years we will not prepare another altar in the Rectory Chapel.

Good Friday – April 2

For the Adoration of the Holy Cross, no physical contact with the cross will take place; Kissing the Cross is limited solely to the celebrant. The faithful will process to the front of the Church maintaining physical distance. The Cross will be held by the Priest or the Altar Servers and faithful can venerate the Cross either with a bow or genuflection. The Stations of the Cross will take place immediately after Good Friday Service.

Easter Vigil in the Holy Night – April 3

We will celebrate the Easter Vigil Mass on April 3rd at 8 PM. The blessing of fire, the procession with Easter Candle will take place as usual. Since all would need to remove the masks and exhale forcefully to extinguish them, the use of small lit candles by the faithful will not be used this year. The holy water font will remain empty. The faithful will be sprinkled with fresh holy water for the renewal of the baptismal promises.

Wishing you the promise of brighter days and a very blessed Pasch as we rejoice in the knowledge that Jesus has risen from the dead.
