ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE

As you are likely aware, the state of New York has begun to lift or rollback many COVID19 pandemic restrictions. Yesterday, Governor Cuomo announced the following changes to these restrictions.

- Effective May 19, 2021, there will be no capacity restriction on houses of worship. However, the six-foot social distance requirement will remain in effect;
- Effective May 19, 2021, capacity for indoor non-essential gatherings is 250 persons, subject to physical distancing guidelines;
- Effective May 10, 2021, capacity for outdoor non-essential gatherings is 500 persons, subject to physical distancing guidelines (two meters).

Note that if you are planning a festival or feast and seek to exceed the 500-person outdoor gathering restriction, you may consider contacting your county health department for a final determination as to whether your event may exceed the 500-person occupancy limit;

- Mask restrictions are to remain in place for the time being.

Prayers and Voluntary Collection for India's Massive COVID-19 Surge

Timothy Cardinal Dolan will lead the faithful in praying the rosary for the people of India who are sick and suffering from the coronavirus at 11:00 am on Saturday, May 8, 2021 at the Shrine of Mary, Help of Christians, located at 174 Filors Lane in Stony Point. The cardinal extends a special invitation to Indian American Catholic priests and parishioners to join him in praying in a special way for the people of India, where the coronavirus continues to have a devastating impact. In announcing his visit to the Shrine, the cardinal said, "Thanks be to God, we seem to have turned a corner in our battle against this disease in our country, but we are also to care for those who are suffering elsewhere. Prayer is the most powerful weapon we have, and by praying the rosary we will call upon our Blessed Mother Mary, to intercede with her Son, Jesus on behalf of those who are still struggling to overcome the effects of the pandemic." Cardinal Dolan has also asked the parishes of the archdiocese to consider raising funds to help alleviate the suffering in India, as they have generously done on many other occasions in the past to help people in need. Any funds raised will be sent to the Catholic Near East Welfare Association, a papal humanitarian relief agency, which is already working in India to assist the poor and suffering, regardless of their faith. The cardinal trusts that you will find the best way of making this known to our people. You may wish to announce an emergency second collection this Sunday, May 9 or, perhaps, in its place, you may wish to make a parish donation and/or invite parishioners to send in their own gifts. Whichever you choose, please forward checks, payable to the Archdiocese of New York, to the finance office, room 1940. We would like to receive them by the end of May, if possible.
