From Fr. Joselin...

Dear Parishioners,

Last week I had someone coming to do little work in our church and he asked me about the attendance in the church before and after the Pandemic. Without even thinking for a while I said, we have more attendance after the Pandemic than before. I said what I see. It is true that we have more attendance for the weekend Mass this summer and I pray it will continue the same way. The man who I was talking to had told me; last year alone, in his diocese, they closed at least 20 churches because there were no people to attend mass. In one of the Churches, when a Priest had his last Mass on a Sunday, just 6 people attended Mass. Now a days many churches are either being closed or merged due to lack of attendance. I am extremely glad; we have most of our Parishioners attending Weekend Mass, but I feel it is not enough. I wish and pray, everyone in our community should attend the Church regularly, unless they have something important going on, that weekend. Back in my Parish in India, we have 2000 registered families and we have just 2 Mass on Sunday. First Mass is at 5.30 AM and the second Mass is at 7.15 AM. For those two Mass, the Church will be packed, and no one will be exempted from attending Mass. No matter how busy they are, without attending Mass they will never do anything. I want all of us to understand, we have 168 hours in a week, out of 168 hours you do whatever you feel important for 167 hours. Please give just 1 hour to the Lord. I do not ask you to give 10 hours or 20 hours out of 168 hours but all I ask is, please give 1 hour to the Lord out of 168 hours. As you schedule your program in advance on your calendar, schedule the Mass also on your calendar either on Saturday or Sunday for one hour. I hope all of us will do that. Please tell your family members also to do the same. My prayers for all of you.
