WELCOME TO FR. GORDON ... Please welcome Fr. Bill Gordon who will celebrate the Masses here at St. Patrick's this weekend. Fr. Lewis continues his recovery and will celebrate the weekend Masses at St. Mary's.

WEEKDAY MASSES ... Please continue to check your bulletin each week for the Mass schedule. This week, we will have Masses on Monday and Friday at St. Patrick's and on Thursday at St. Mary's. We will also have a Communion Service on Wednesday at St. Patrick's. With this in mind, any Masses that have already been scheduled on weekdays may be rescheduled to a later date. We will do our best to have all these Masses said in a timely fashion. We are sorry for any inconvenience that this may cause you.

SECOND COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND ... The second collection this weekend is taken up for the Missionary Projects of the Diocese of Ogdensburg. A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community may be admitted in the company of a Catholic sponsor, serving as a Christian witness. **CEMETERY INFORMATION**

All cemetery rules and regulations can be obtained from the Rectory. The cost of each cemetery lot at both cemeteries, including endowed care, is \$400. **As of July 1, 2017, the cost to open and close a grave is now \$500.** Opening and closing of cremation graves remains at \$150.

All cremations and full burials in both St. Patrick's and St. Joseph's Cemeteries are to be done by our approved grave digger. Absolutely no digging without the permission of the Parish Office. This ensures that each burial is in accordance with our required specifications and that accurate locations and proper recordings of burials can be maintained. Foundations for monuments, flatstones or military markers are also to be installed by cemetery employees or approved persons only.
