WEEKDAY MASSES ... Starting on Monday, September 4, we will resume our regular weekday Mass schedule, which includes 9:00AM Masses on Monday and Tuesday at St. Patrick's and Thursday and Friday at St. Mary's. We will have a Communion Service on Wednesdays at 9:00AM at St. Patrick's. Please bear in mind that circumstances do arise that require us to cancel Masses so we apologize in advance for any inconvenience that this might cause.

2017 BISHOP'S FUND APPEAL The week of September 10, you will receive a letter and brochure from Bishop LaValley asking you to join him in supporting the 2017 Bishop's Fund Appeal. SISTER TO SERVE OUR PARISH ... As mentioned a few months ago, Bishop LaValley announced that the Sisters of the Cross of Chavanod will open a convent at the present rectory in Cadyville this summer.. One of the Sisters of the Cross will serve both at St. Patrick's and St. Mary's as a Pastoral Associate. It is anticipated that she will be arriving around the beginning of September. While details of her job description are still being worked out, it is anticipated that she will be involved in hospital visits, home visits, nursing home visits, youth ministry, faith formation programs and other duties to be determined. We are so fortunate to have the arrival of these sisters in our area.

CHRISTIAN FORMATION

Confirmation is also a two-year program and students must complete eighth and ninth grades in order to make their Confirmation. Sunday and Holyday Mass attendance is also a requirement.
