CAPITAL CAMPAIGN ... The Diocesan-wide Capital Campaign "**It's Our Church, It's Our Future**" has begun. The **It's Our Church, It's Our Future** Capital Campaign will have a goal of \$16 million, which will include \$1.3 million for the 2018 Bishop's Fund Appeal. Of the funds raised, 75% will remain at the Parish for its local needs such as programs and capital improvements. The remaining 25% benefits the entire Diocese supporting Retired Priests, Seminarians, Camp Guggenheim and St. Mary's Cathedral.

Guidance In Giving, Inc. (GIG) is working with the Diocese on this endeavor and have begun the groundwork with some parishes participating in the initial Block 1 Phase. "**It's Our Church, It's Our Future**" will run in three blocks beginning with Block 1 running April to June. Parishes in Block 2 participate from June to September and campaigns in Parishes in Block 3 take place from September to November. Preparations for Block 3, which includes St. Patrick's and St. Mary's, will begin in July.
