CEMETERY INFORMATION

All cemetery rules and regulations can be obtained from the Rectory. The cost of each cemetery lot at both cemeteries, including endowed care, is \$400. **The cost to open and close a grave is \$500.** Opening and closing of cremation graves is \$150.

All cremations and full burials in both St. Patrick's and St. Joseph's Cemeteries are to be done by our approved grave digger. Absolutely no digging without the permission of the Parish Office. This ensures that each burial is in accordance with our required specifications and that accurate locations and proper recordings of burials can be maintained. Foundations for monuments, flatstones or military markers are also to be installed by cemetery employees or approved persons only.
