CHANGE OF MASS TIMES FOR SUNDAY, AUGUST 19 ONLY ... Next Sunday, August 19, St. Patrick's 10:00AM Mass will be at 8:00AM and St. Mary's 8:00AM Mass will be at 10:00AM to accommodate our car show. Thank you for your understanding.

MISSIONARY CO-OP PLAN ... The Special Second Collection for the Missionary Cooperation Plan will take place next weekend, August 18/19. At that time, we will have a guest priest from the Maryknoll Society, Fr. Doug May, SM, who will speak at all our Masses. Fr. Doug is originally from the Buffalo, NY area and had worked in Egypt and the Middle East for over 22 years. One of the projects he worked on is a home & school for mentally handicapped children. It has been open since 2004. Fr. Doug served in Cairo, Egypt where he had been helping to support and accompany the Coptic Catholic priests who were his students over the years when he taught at the Coptic Catholic Seminary in Maadi, Cairo. He also had been writing on current religious and civil events happening in Cairo and providing sacramental and liturgical ministry to Catholic Communities throughout Cairo. Currently, Fr. Doug is assigned to Maryknoll's Church Engagement Department. Fr. Doug will be happy to talk with any parishioners who are interested in doing overseas mission work as a Maryknoll Priest, Brother, Lay Missionary or Sister. PROTECTION OF HUMAN LIFE ... You are invited to join Catholics nationwide in a weekly moment of prayer from August to late September 2018 for the legal protection of human life. As soon as Supreme Court Justice Anthony Kennedy announced his retirement, pro-abortion groups began lobbying the U.S. Senate to reject any nominee who does not promise to endorse *Roe v. Wade*. We should certainly raise grave concerns about a confirmation process that is being grossly distorted by efforts to subject judicial nominees to a litmus test of support for abortion. And we must pray. Each Friday, from August 3 to September 28, 2018, we'll have the opportunity to join a nine-week effort of prayer, fasting and education that a change in the U.S. Supreme Court will move our nation closer to the day when every human being is protected in law and welcomed in life. As part of the USCCB Call to Prayer, participants can receive weekly prayer reminders by text message or email. In addition to the current invitation to fast on Fridays, participants will be encouraged to pray one *Our Father*, three *Hail Marys*, and one *Glory Be* for this intention and will receive important facts about how *Roe* is not health care, is bad law, and fails women. We encourage you to sign up at www.usccb.org/pray for this and the continuing Call to Prayer initiatives. May our Lady of Guadalupe intercede for the healing of our nation and our people from decades of abortion on demand.

Hear my prayers, and increase in me the will to follow your Son Jesus.

Help me to draw on the resources of my faith as I use the opportunities of our democracy to shape a society more respectful of the life, dignity, and rights of the human person, especially the poor and vulnerable.
